Dear Parents,

The 2023-2024 Dublin ISD COVID-19 protocol has been revised and is as follows:

If your child has tested positive for COVID19, he/she will be sent home to quarantine for 5 days.

Family members no longer need to quarantine if they are symptom free. The campus nurse will monitor them daily for 5 days post exposure.

If your child has COVID-19 symptoms and is not evaluated by a medical profession or tested for COVID-19 it will be assumed he/she has COVID-19, and may not return to campus until the five-day quarantine has been met.

During quarantine your student will not be allowed on campus for the five-day quarantine period. This includes after school activities, and extracurricular activities.

If your child has been exposed to COVID-19 within 90 days of a positive test, they will not need to quarantine. The school Nurse will monitor them for 5 days post exposure.

Dublin ISD will be offering COVID-19 testing to students and staff free of charge this year. We will also have TeleHealth available at each campus Nurses Office. If you are interested in a TeleHealth appointment with a doctor, please reach out to the school nurse. Through our TeleHealth, we offer Covid-19, Flu A and B, and Strep testing.

List of COVID-19 Related Symptoms

- *Fever or Chills
- *Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- *Significant muscle pain or body aches
- *Loss of taste or smell
- *Congestion or runny nose

- *Fatigue
- *Severe Headache
- *Severe Sore throat
